## **Ambassador**

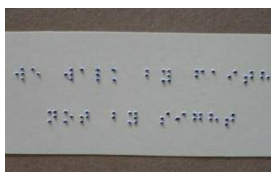
Diane Morris and her team spread goodwill to everyone throughout the weekend. If this is your first time at AWARE, Diane and her team will ensure that all your needs are met.
