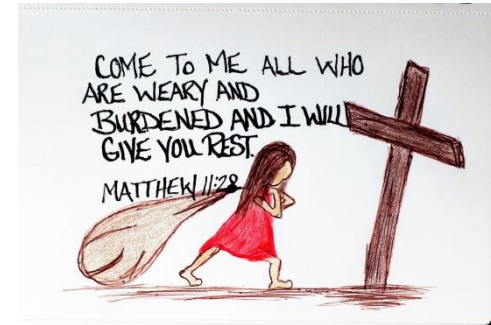
BURSARIES
